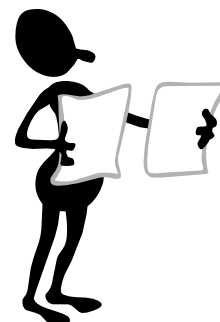

Workshop description:

This workshop will address the interview and performance aspects of interpreter certification processes. For the interview portion, discussion about a systematic format for responding to ethical dilemmas will be provided as well as a complex ethically based scenario to analyze. The performance component of this workshop will address the discrete aspects of the interpreting process and provide the participants with a tool upon which they can determine their readiness to test.

Participants in this workshop **will be required** to bring a short 10-20 minute sample of their work. The goal of this workshop is to determine the test readiness and to provide a tool with which interpreters can gauge that readiness. The sample will be used (and is required for each person participating) to apply the self-analysis tool and to be provided guidance from the facilitator.

She has written a business practices manual for interpreters "It's a Matter of \$'s & \$ense" which has an accompanying CD Rom with forms and information for interpreters. Lynne graduated from SW Collegiate Institute for the Deaf, possesses an undergraduate degree in Organizational Leadership, an MBA, was a member of the first cohort of the University of Colorado's Master Mentor Program, completed one year of law school and is currently working on her Ph.D. in Training & Performance Improvement.
